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| Objectives | Help a fellow with a case by searching way of solutions with different angles |
| Target | Group of young teachers with a case (a problematic he had with a student) |
| When | At a group coaching session |
| Methodology and timing | <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The fellow/teacher introduce the case he has with a student 5'2. The other fellows/teachers and the coach shoot questions 5'3. The fellow/teacher answers the questions 5'4. The fellow/teacher is turning his back to the fellows/teachers and the coach while they discuss the case 10'5. The fellow/teacher concludes by sharing his take aways 5' |
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| Advices | The teacher really has to turn his back so that his colleagues don't see his face while they discuss the case, they are not influenced by his reactions. |
