<b>Objectives</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. To prepare for turning children into classroom beasts</li><li>2. To be able to better block one's time when the school starts</li></ol>

<b>Methodology and timing</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. There are 4 CATEGORIES : I want, I belong, I can, I know how</li><li>2. Teacher prepares activities and goals intended to strengthen these aspirations and beliefs in their students</li><li>3. A good CoA plan should contain at least 3 activities for each category.</li><li>4. Teacher also includes when they will take place and how they will track progress</li></ol>
	
<b>Advices</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Make sure that all goals are SMART</li><li>2. It is ok to change CoA plan thorough the year - every class responds to different techniques.</li></ol>
